

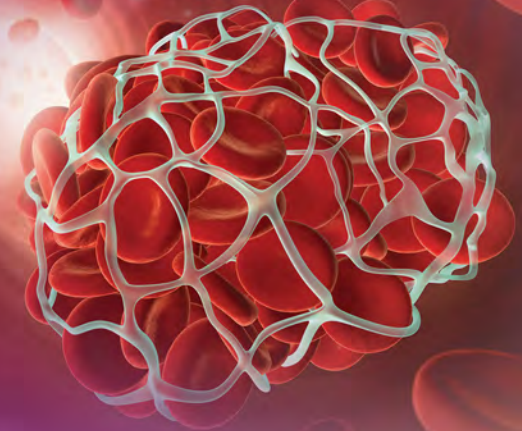
Thrombosis in the UK & Europe
